- General Information**
- There is currently a waiting time of 3 and above years before an assessment is carried out by the Neuro Team & a wait time of 9 months for consultation meetings under the new assessment system.
 - Wait times for pupils to be assessed by the speech and language team are around 2 years.
 - In February 2026 the government released a new white paper entitled 'Every Child Achieving and Thriving' which outlines proposed reforms to SEND provision.
